



NYCDOT Hunts Point Clean Trucks Program Reaches 500 Truck Milestone

An exciting milestone was reached!

The New York City Department of Transportation (NYC DOT) Hunts Point Clean Trucks Program (HPCTP) reached a milestone by replacing 500 older heavy-polluting diesel trucks with 2010 EPA emission compliant diesel-hybrid, compressed natural gas, and diesel Class 3 to Class 8 trucks. The HPCTP has replaced food distribution, beverage delivery, commercial carrier, waste and recycling, fuel service, cement, and moving and storage trucks.

These 500 new trucks have resulted in significant environmental benefits by helping to improve air quality in the South Bronx since the launch of the program in 2012. Many community members joined the celebration of this milestone.

The program administrators thanked the South Bronx business community for doing their part to make the Hunts Point Clean Trucks Program a big success.
